



POLICY:

REGULATION: JHFC Unlinked Portables – Student Placement

EXHIBIT:

Enrolment growth in Seine River School Division has resulted in the continued need for unlinked portables at different school sites. Decisions to place classes and students in unlinked portables will have student safety as the top priority for all classroom assignment decisions. School principals will place the oldest students in unlinked portables unless there are justifiable reasons such as student access or other educational reasons.

In situations where the oldest grade is not placed in unlinked portables the next oldest grade will be assigned to the portable. Additionally, the school principal must notify the Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction with the reasons for the classroom placement decision.

Principals will ensure that appropriate communication, supervision and emergency response plans are developed specifically for unlinked portable classrooms.

This regulation will come into effect in September 2012.
