



POLICY: **IKFB** GRADUATION EXERCISES
(Safe Grad)

REGULATION:

EXHIBIT:

1. Each High School shall organize its own graduation activities by forming a joint committee of teachers, parents and students.
2. The School Board endorses the Safe Grad Program.
3. High School certificates signed by the Chairperson of the Board, the Superintendent and the Principal shall be issued to all successful candidates as follows:
 - a) the “Regular Certificate”: a certificate which indicates that the student has met the minimum requirements for graduation, as set out by the Department of Education, i.e. 28 credits;
 - b) the “Certificate of Excellence”: a certificate which would indicate that the student has distinguished himself by obtaining the following results:
 - either 28 credits with an average of 80%
 - or 30 credits with an average of 75%
 - or 32 credits with an average of 70%
4. Division bursaries will be made available to each school to recognize general academic excellence and student achievement.
