This Seine River School Division policy, and its corresponding regulation, follows the principles of The Human Rights Code.

The Seine River School Division will strive to promote respect for diversity within its schools, learning environments, workplaces and communities. The school division will support learning environments and workplaces that are free of negative conduct or actions (based on gender bias, sexual stereotyping, sexual orientation, gender identity, religious beliefs, ethnicity, and or cultural practices).

Seine River School Division expects staff and students to support safe and inclusive learning environments by respecting human diversity and refraining from expressing negative conduct or actions based on gender bias, sexual stereotyping, sexual orientation, gender identity, religious beliefs, ethnicity, and or cultural practices.

Students and staff in Seine River School Division must respect human diversity. Students, parents or staff who identify themselves on the basis of sexual orientation or gender identity will be treated with respect and with confidentiality.
